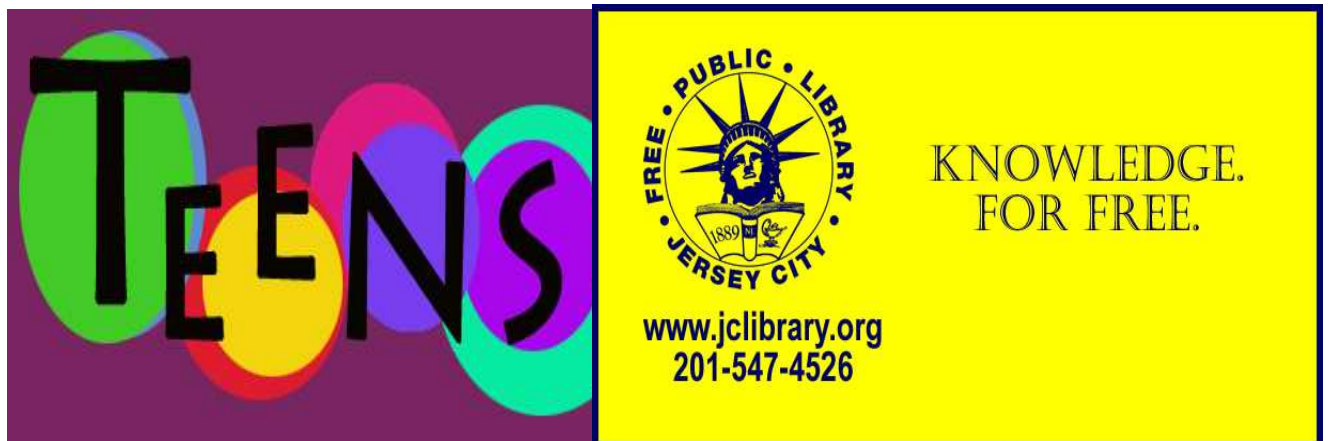
What is TAB?
